On Saturday, November 6th at 2:00 p.m. cooking will begin and at 6:00 p.m. Eating will begin to decide the best bean in the house.

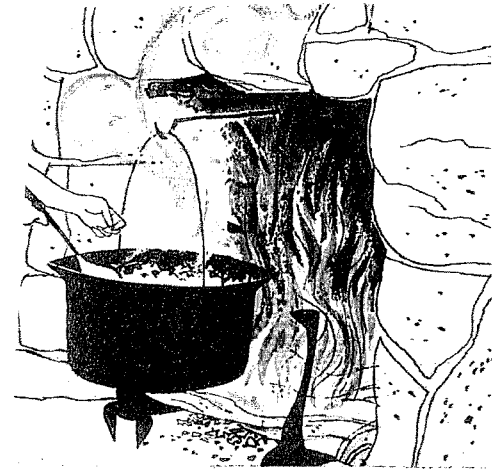
